

THE OFFICE OF ADVISING, CAREER & TRANSFER

The team in the Office of Advising, Career & Transfer at MWCC, fosters an intentional teaching and learning collaboration between students, professional advisors and faculty. No matter the modality of advising (academic, career or transfer), this practice is focused on empowering students to articulate and achieve their goals, while cultivating individual growth.

Academic Advising-Students are assigned faculty or professional staff academic advisors based on their academic program. Throughout their enrollment at MWCC, Advisors will guide students by helping them select courses that meet degree requirements; explain academic standards, college policies, and procedures; and help students access support services.

Students should meet with their Advisor often (at least once a semester) to ensure they are making wise academic decisions. Students also should consult with their Advisor prior to adding or dropping courses; changing their academic program; if they are experiencing difficulty in courses, or are having any problems that interfere with educational progress.

It is extremely important that students follow their Advisor's recommendations in order to achieve their academic goals. Faculty and professional staff advisors are available to assist students in setting and achieving these educational goals. Yet, ultimately, students are responsible for making sure they meet their degree and graduation requirements.

Career Advising-The Career Coordinator will work with students on all aspects of career planning and placement. From helping guide career exploration, to reviewing job search documents, to connecting students to job opportunities, we provide a 'full service' approach to our students' career goals and aspirations.

Transfer Advising-The Transfer Advisor works with students who have an interest in transferring into a selective MWCC program or a 4-year College or University. This Advisor will work with students to ensure that they know all of their options, meet the criteria for transfer, and adhere to the deadlines of prospective institutions.
